Her dedication, hard work, and passion for learning are truly commendable. We wish Ananya continued success and many more laurels in the years ahead.

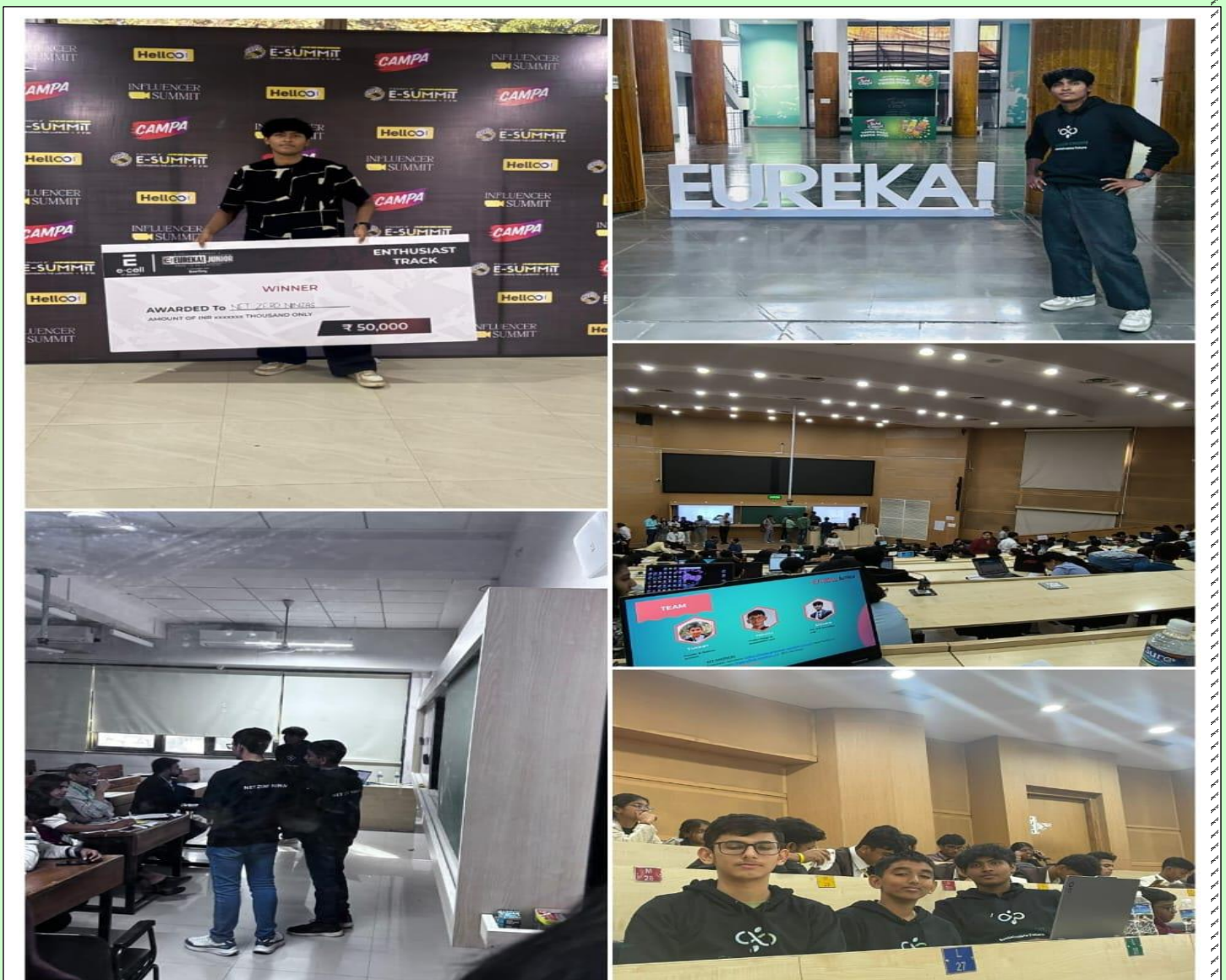

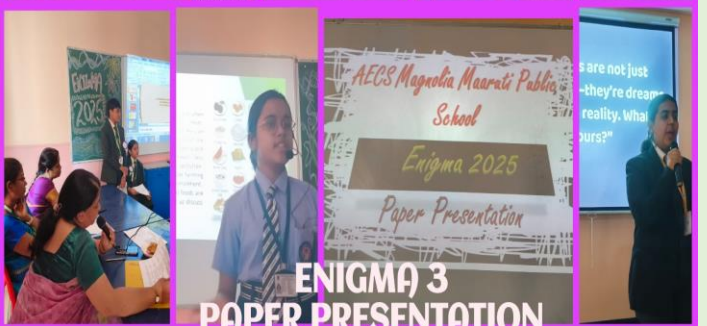
